That you show cause to this Honourable court why a final order should not be made in the following terms:

1. The Respondents' be and are hereby ordered to refrain from visiting house number 33A Clark Road, Surburbs, Bulawayo for whatever reason except in the company of the Applicants legal practitioners.

INTERIM RELIEF GRANTED


Pending the finalization of this matter, the Applicant be granted the following relief:-

1. The Applicants be and are hereby restored to full possession and occupation of House No. 33A Clark Road, Surburbs, Bulawayo.
2. The Respondents be and are hereby directed to order and facilitate the immediate withdrawal of all police officers from the aforesaid house and the surrounding yard.
3. The Respondents be and are hereby directed to ensure that nothing is removed from the aforesaid house without due process.

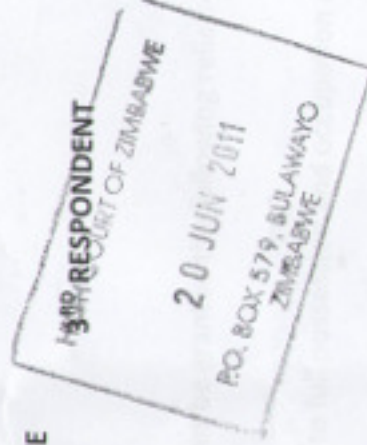

TAKE NOTICE that on the 20th day of June 2011, the Honourable Mr. Justice Mathonsi sitting at the High Court in Bulawayo, issued a Provisional Order as shown overleaf.

If you intend to oppose the confirmation of this provisional order, you will have to file a Notice of Opposition in **Form No. 29B**, together with one or more opposing affidavits, with the Registrar of the High Court at **Bulawayo** within **twelve days** after the date on which the Provisional Order and annexures were served on you. You will also have to serve a copy of the Notice of Opposition and affidavit on the Applicant at the address for service specified in the Application.

If you do not file an opposing affidavit within the specified period above, this matter will be set down for hearing in the High Court at Bulawayo without further notice to you and will be dealt with as an unopposed application for confirmation of the Provisional Order.

IF you wish to have the Provisional Order changed or set aside sooner than the Rules of the Court normally allow and can show good cause for this, you should approach the Applicant's Legal Practitioner to agree, in consultation with the Registrar, on a suitable hearing date. If this
