Take note that we act on the instructions of our client the Women of Zimbabwe Arise (WOZA).

We are advised that on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup> of June 2011 your officers raided the above address and harassed the people found therein in an endeavour to compel them to disclose the whereabouts of one Jennifer Williams and Magondonga Mahlangu.

We are further advised that you searched the place in and out looking for undisclosed materials.

We are also further advised that you have mounted police officers at the said house who have maintained a continuous presence throughout the day and night.

First of all we wonder whether the search was conducted on the strength of a warrant or not. This is more so considering that when we visited the house upon being contacted by our clients your officers blatantly ordered us to leave the place thereby denying our clients their right to legal representation at that stage.
