WOZA noted with concern that there has been no formal response to our complaint and that members continue to face harassment and intimidation. Today alone 4 members report calls from 60248 asking them to become informer for financial reward.

It is also not WOZA alone, our civic society partners, ZimRights, CSU, Zimbabwe Peace Project, youth organisations NYTD, YIDEZ have also faced raids and harassment.

Only yesterday 8 members were arrested after brutal beatings at parliament only to be released within 2 hours.

We march today to peacefully demand an end to this partisan behaviour and abuse of power and adherence to the code of conduct and the principle of investigate before arrest not arrest to investigate.
